

## **Membership By-law 2.0**

Amended May 20 2023

Membership is the lifeblood of the organization. The ideal member journey needs to be outlined and continually improved upon.

Member value needs to be challenged and enhanced where possible. Current members need to be communicated with on an ongoing basis as well as rewarded for their loyalty. Membership should be seamless for someone to sign up and pay for. All memberships need to be entered and paid for online or a form filled out to ensure consistency of information capture.

### **Membership Levels**

**Individual Membership:** This level of membership is for one person 18 years or older; and will entitle the member to cast a vote at an Annual meeting or General meeting of the members. In the case of a single parent family this membership will cover the members' children up to age 18.

**Family Membership:** This level of membership will cover 2 adults 18 years or older and their children all living in the same household. This will entitle both adults to vote at any Annual or General meetings of the members. Once a child turns 18, they are no longer covered under the family membership and will be required to purchase an individual or family membership to be a member in good standing.

For a family membership, parental consent will be required for family members under the age of 16 to participate in activities.

### **Corporate Memberships**

Corporate memberships include priority access to sponsor monthly emails, access to website advertising, discounted event participation and advertising around the Centre and listing on the Corporate Directory. Corporate members will not be eligible to vote.
